PROGRAM OUTCOMES

In 2023, our Education program saw a 63% increase in reading comprehension, with over 5,091 hours of student reading completed. We also saw a 12.6% increase in student's Bible literacy.

In 2023, our Essential Food program provided food for 20,116 people, and processed over 333,516 pounds of food. We also provided 14,391 nutritious meals to children.

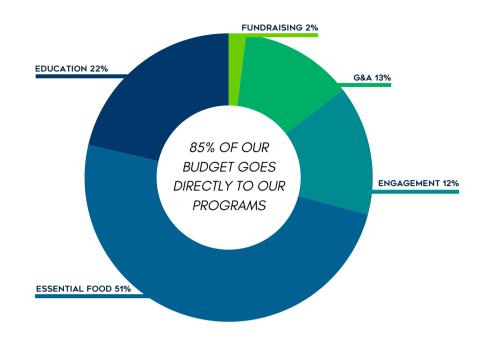
